

## **Grading practices and policies**

EV Online Learning utilizes the Written Student Learning Plans to determine the length of time a student will have to complete a course. Students who do not complete their assignments within the agreed upon time frame will need to log time on task for their assignments in order for the timeframe to be adjusted on the Written Student Learning Plan.

## **Dropping a Class**

After the first two weeks of being assigned a course, any student-initiated dropped course may be reported as an “F” Grade on the student’s transcript.

## **Course Requirements and Grading Policies**

Students are entitled to an explanation of the requirements of the course of study and the basis for which grades will be determined. In accordance with the Alternative Learning Experience (ALE) RCWs, the Written Student Learning Plan and course outline (scope and sequence) will be used to track student achievement and to assist with the grading practices.

Grades:

Due to the use of the Written Student Learning Plan and the fact our mentors and teachers contact students and parents/guardians weekly regarding the work and course of study for all students, elementary, middle and high school level; EV Online Learning will issue progress reports/report cards and/or will post grades onto transcripts as follows:

- As courses are completed based on the timeline listed on the Written Student Learning Plan, grade results will be sent to students and will be posted to transcripts for high school and middle school students.
- Semester grades:
  - January: Grades mailed to elementary and middle school families
  - June: Mailed to elementary and middle school families

A monthly determination of adequate learning progress is a requirement of the ALE regulations. This, in and of itself is a form of grade/study reporting to families.
